Therefore, healthy and welleducated children, their first ideas about nature and society, their spirituality, system of views grow and develop a lot first in the family, and then in preschool educational organizations. improvement of the process of new reforms in this system and the fact that positive changes are being observed is a direct evidence that special attention has been paid to the preschool education system in recent years. It is because the influence of the family environment on the upbringing of children of preschool age has a positive character that the educational process in the following social institutions will definitely be put on a systematic and good track. That is why it is necessary to pay serious attention to children's formation, mental, moral and physical maturity, and their socialization from the pre-school period. In fact, the role of the family, educational institutions, and especially preschool education is incomparable in the socialization of a person. Today, along with other stages of education, special attention is paid to the fundamental development of preschool education. In particular, on the basis of the concept of development of the preschool education system of the Republic of Uzbekistan until 2030, "creating conditions for the intellectual, moral, aesthetic and physical development of preschool children in all aspects, introducing innovations, advanced pedagogical and information and communication technologies into the preschool education system" measures are being implemented [2].

The formation of a children's team is a complex process that requires a long time. Initially joint activities often merge into world-related activities. This union is unstable, short-lived and quickly breaks. The first organizer of such an initial union in the life of children (kindergarten) is the educator. Because he manages joint activities with children, organizes a children's team through games. One of the children loads the toys, the second carries them, and the third unloads the load. Or 4-5 girls play the game "Family" with a doll, and the teacher helps them to divide the roles. In the process of joint activity, play and work are widely used. At this stage, the teacher's task is to form organizational skills in all children.

The following skills are formed in the process of working as a team in the socialization of preschool children:

- worldview: the assimilation of social values and ideals by a person, the formation and development of interests that determine his direction and attitude;
- social awareness: awareness of the surrounding world and identity, acquisition of independent thinking skills;
- social and personal characteristics: mastering social roles; the social experience of the behavior reflected in the community, its social position, social role is realized in the community, it accumulates social experience;
 - behavior: the field of everyday self-expression;
- aesthetic culture: mastering environmental culture; forms of behavior and activity manifested in the culture of communication, activity and behavior the field of internal culture;

In the period of preparation for school, the following types of team educational cooperation can be implemented: implementation of educational cooperation between educators and students; organization of educational cooperation of children with their peers in the group; such as implementation of the child's self-awareness and communication with the studied educational materials during the preparation process [3].

The work carried out by the preschool education organization in cooperation with parents is of particular importance in the comprehensive development of preschool children in accordance with their age, quality preparation for school education. In the process of education, it is necessary to

Therefore, communication with parents, mutual respect, recognition of the importance of the child's interests served as the basis for effective cooperation. Thus, if each educator organizes all activities in cooperation with parents in preparing children for school, children will make great progress and achieve good results quickly. For this reason, it is necessary to constantly search and apply effective ways of cooperation with parents.

In short, the social environment and community are of particular importance in the socialization of preschool children, their comprehensive development, physical health and independent thinking skills. Therefore, comprehensive study of preschool children allows to teach them to learn, to work, to themselves, to the surrounding environment, to distinguish the most important qualities necessary for human development.
